And about b the fourth watch of the night z he came to them, walking on the sea. e He meant to pass by them, 49 but when they saw him walking on the sea they thought it was a ghost, and cried out, 50 for they all saw him and d were terrified. But immediately he spoke to them and said, e “Take heart; it is I. e Do not be
